## Symptoms of Coronavirus (COVID-19)


**Know the symptoms of COVID-19, which can include the following:**




**Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing**




**Fever or chills**



**Muscle or body aches**



**Vomiting or diarrhea**




**New loss of taste or smell**

**Symptoms can range from mild to severe illness, and appear 2-14 days after you are exposed to the virus that causes COVID-19.**

**Seek medical care immediately if someone has emergency warning signs of COVID-19.**

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face

This list is not all possible symptoms. Please call your healthcare provider for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.
